In 2021 she obtained the Second Level University Master Degree in Clinical and Experimental Neuropsychology (Director Prof. S. Tamburin) promoted by the Department of Neuroscience, Biomedicine and Movement, University of Verona.

In 2018 she obtained a first level university degree in Psychoneuroendocrino-immunology (PNEI) (Director Prof. G. Abbate Daga) promoted by the Department of Neuroscience, University of Turin.

From 24 to 28 May 2017 she attended the Conference of the Society of Psychoneuroendocrine-Immunology (in collaboration with ISNIM) in Rome.

From 22 to 26 September 2014 she attended the course "Neural Development and Neurodevelopmental Disorders" organized by Dr. A. Buffo and Prof. Magistetto at the University of Turin (about 40 hours of training).

From 1997 to the present, she has participated in courses, conferences and seminars related to her main professional interests (neurosciences, psychosomatics, psychoneuroendocrine-immunology, psychoanalytic psychotherapy, developmental psychopathology, postpartum depression, parenting, learning disorders - DSA) for an average of 20-50 CME credits per year.

In 2005 she attended the training course "Psychodiagnostics with the Rorschach Test - Exner Method" at LIRIPAC, Faculty of Psychology, University of Padua (about 40 hours of training).

In 2000 she attended the course "Assessment of Neonatal Behaviour and Promotion of Behavioural Development" at the Brazelton Centre in Florence (given by Dr. G. Rapisardi).

From 1997 to 2004 she supervised her clinical work weekly with a qualified supervisor from the Bonaccorsi Institute, Dr Caterina Barbarotto Moso.

In 1997 she completed her training at the same Institute, Foundation F. Bonaccorsi, with an additional year of training in adult psychotherapy.

In 1996 she obtained a Master's Degree in Psychotherapy for Children and Adolescents at the F. Bonaccorsi Institute in Milan (Italian Institute for Psychotherapy, Training and Research, recognized by the MIUR), after almost 2000 hours of training, divided into personal analysis of the classical type (700 hours) and weekly classes at the Institute (1280 hours).

Between 1985 and 1995 she attended integrative lectures and research seminars at the University of Padua with the most renowned professors and researchers in the field of developmental psychopathology (Prof. Daniel Stern, Prof. Palacio Espasa, Prof. Zeanah, Prof. Soulé, Prof. Sameroff), for a total of about one hundred hours of training.

Between 1990 and 1991 she attended a specialization course on the relational approach to developmental psychopathology at the University of Modena (66 hours of training) and a pre-training course in family therapy at the Institute for Family Therapy in Vicenza (160 hours).

Between October 1989 and September 1990 she did a 12-month (then voluntary) internship (20 hours a week) at the Child Neuropsychiatry Service in Vicenza.

Between 1987 and 1988 she attended, on a voluntary basis, the paediatric neuropsychiatry service of Prof. Pajno Ferrara at the Policlinico G.B. Rossi in Borgo Roma, Verona (about 200 hours).

Graduated in Psychology (4-years Italian Laurea) in July 1989 (110/110 with honors) at the Faculty of Psychology of the University of Padua, with a thesis on Psychopathology of the Developmental Age, prepared by following a 12-month clinical follow-up of a sample of premature babies at high psychological risk at the Neonatal Pathology Unit of the Department of Paediatrics of the University of Padua (supervisor Prof. G.M. Fava Vizziello).
